AOTR – Rider must have a current "Declaration of Amateur Status" on file with NAPHA and

must be the registered owner, spouse or child of registered owner of the horse. This division leads to high point prize only and winners do not cross-qualify into Amateur Performance Championships.

PC – Past DSPHC and/or Magnolia Classic Champions

PNC – Past National Champions

V – Indicates a qualifying option for the Versatility High Point Horse Award – Must choose one Gait, one Breeding, one Performance and one elective, Horses may enter more than 4 classes, but points will be calculated from best scores in each of these 4 categories

Purse Class distributions - (Class 21) – 100% of entry fees for this class will be awarded to winners in the following manner: 50% 1<sup>st</sup> place, 30% 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 20% 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

Tiebreaker information -

Junior High Point and Reserve; Novice High Point: In case of a tie, the tied rider with the highest placement in its Equitation class will be declared the winner. Should entries still be tied, the Performance class points will be added to the Equitation score to determine the winner.

AOTR, Amateur Exhibitor, Versatility and Crystal: In case of a tie, the tied rider with the highest placement in its Gait class will be declared the winner. Should entries still be tied, the Performance class points will be added to the Gait score to determine the winner.

\*\*\* Cash Prizes – Cash Prizes are awarded to owner of horse AFTER show balance is satisfied.
